General Election November 3, 2020

The General Election will take place on November 3rd. All registered voters are eligible to vote. The deadline to register to vote is October 5th. The information below is for voting in both Maricopa and Yavapai County, not just the Town of Wickenburg. All residents of Maricopa County can drop off their voted ballots at Town Hall or vote at the Community Center on election day. Yavapai County residents can go to the Congress polls.

There are four ways to receive your ballot:

1. Permanent Early Voter List (PEVL) – your ballot will be mailed on October 7th
2. One-Time Ballot by Mail – Call the County Elections Office by October 23rd to be mailed a ballot for this election only
3. Early Voting In-Person – Maricopa County residents can vote at the Community Center October 28 to November 2 from 8:00 am until 5:00 pm – Yavapai County residents have to go to Prescott
4. Vote on Election Day – Polls are open 6:00 am until 7:00 pm – Maricopa County voters vote at the Community Center – Yavapai County voters vote at the Grace Bible Chapel in Congress

There are two ways to return your ballot by mail to be counted:

1. Mail your ballot back
2. Drop off your ballot into a ballot box that is picked up at least twice a week by the County Elections Department – Maricopa County box at Town Hall starting October 19th until election day as well as at Community Center starting October 28th – Yavapai County resident's closest box is at the Skull Valley Post Office

Your safety is a priority, so extra cleaning is taking place at all election sites and masks are highly recommended. The counties are always looking for poll workers to help, if you are interested, please contact the county directly.

For Maricopa County residents, you can receive updates on the status of your mail-in ballot. Sign up at beballotready.vote, to receive a text message when your ballot has been received, when your signature has been verified and when your ballot has been counted.
